The following doses and schedules have been published for single agent vinorelbine in metastatic lung and/or breast cancer:

- First line treatment - 25-30 mg/m² weekly until disease progression.
- Second line treatment - 20-30 mg/m² weekly or 20-30 mg/m² days 1 and 8 every 3 weeks or 30 mg/m² every other week.

If granulocytes 1000-1499 and/or platelets 50,000-99,000, then notify physician and treat as follows:

Premedicate 30 minutes prior to chemotherapy with palonosetron 0.25 mg IV and dexamethasone 20 mg po.
